

U.S. Supreme Court Records & Briefs (1832-1978)

- Unlike the print collection, which is often incomplete, this database contains the full text for every record and brief from 1832-1978
- All records are actual page-images taken from the only existing complete print collection in Philadelphia
- Records can be downloaded and printed in PDF format (up to 50 pages at a time)
- Full text of every record document is searchable

To select multiple Document Types, hold down the Control key while making your selections.


Or, Search by Unique Identifier:

- U.S. Reports citation (e.g. 423 U.S. 1047)
- Supreme Court Reporter citation (e.g. 96 S.Ct. 771)
- Lawyers' Edition citation (e.g. 32 L.Ed.2d 449 or 52 L.Ed. 551)
- Thomson Gale document number

Number of results per page:

- Documents may be retrieved directly by either docket number or by reporter citation
- Limit searches by date, term year, or to a range of years
- Limit searches to specific document type, or select multiple types by holding down the Control key while selecting document types
- To search for a specific author, enter the author's enter "Lastname, Firstname" (or Organization Name), select "Author" from the drop-down menu to the right of the search field, and click "Search"
- To search for a case by name, enter party name(s) in the field and select "Case Name" in the drop-down menu
- Multiple search types may be run simultaneously by using more than one field and drop-down menu
- Activate "Fuzzy Search" for alternate spellings, tenses, or singular/plural

Downloading and Printing:

- All documents can be printed or downloaded in PDF format by selecting the  **Print/View PDF** icon from a document result page
- Note that downloading and printing is restricted to 50 pages of a document at a time, but these pages need not be contiguous
- Enter desired page number(s) or range(s) in the appropriate field from the print screen (E.g., 1, 3, 5-7, 11-15)
- A specific page may also be printed in printer-friendly HTML format

Sources for recent Supreme Court briefs:

The ABA provides PDF versions of briefs going back to the 2003/04 Term. The ABA seems to get access to party briefs and upload them earlier than any other free site. The ABA focuses on the initial main party briefs, but on occasion will have some subsequent or amicus briefs available.

Findlaw may not have the most recent briefs as quickly available at the ABA, but Findlaw is much more comprehensive in the records and briefs it makes available, including all party briefs, amicus briefs, and joint appendices.
