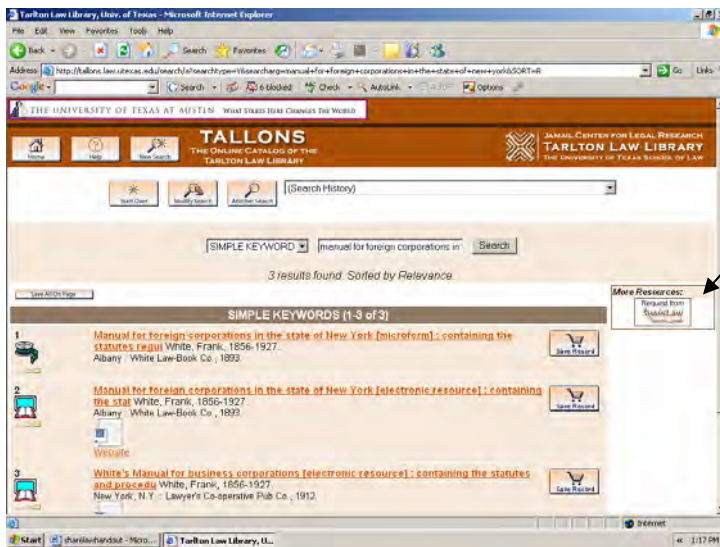


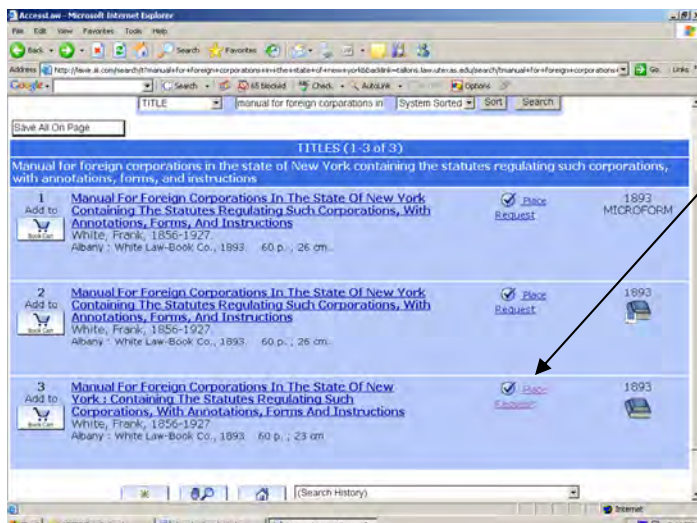
ShareLaw

ShareLaw is a consortium of academic libraries that allows UT Law faculty, staff, and students to directly request materials from other institutions (if those materials are not available on campus). Law libraries participating in the ShareLaw consortium (University of Texas, Yale, Berkeley, University of Pennsylvania, University of Washington, University of Miami, and George Washington University) have agreed to send materials to requesting institutions via overnight delivery.

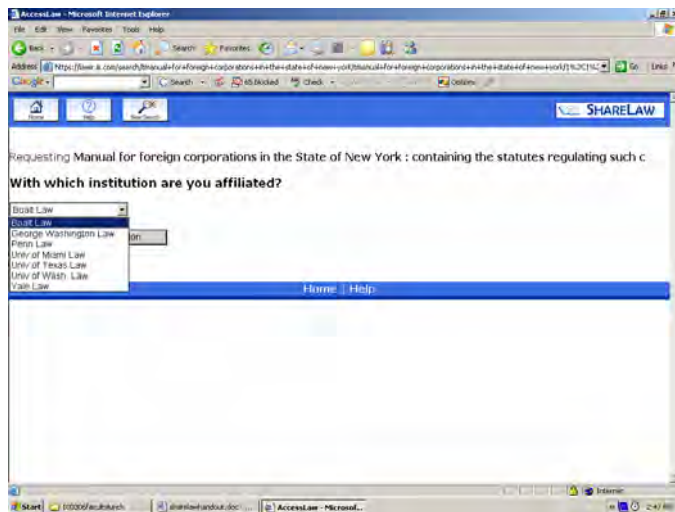
If, after searching for a title on Tallons and not finding it, click on the 'ShareLaw' icon on the retrieved results page.



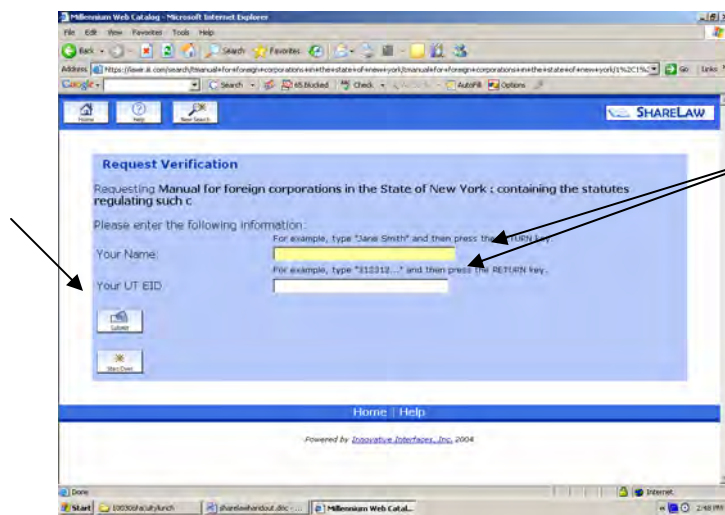
From the results list on ShareLaw, select the title you wish to obtain and click on 'place request.'



You will be asked to identify the institution with which you are affiliated



... and to identify yourself.



Once you have entered the requested information, click on 'submit', and you will receive a message to the effect that your request has been received.
